UNM Trained MDs

The Location Report is produced annually by the Office of Program Evaluation, Education and Research at the University of New Mexico School of Medicine. This report provides a statistical overview of current practice and location information for UNM trained physicians who were licensed and practicing in New Mexico in the past year.

QUICK FACTS:

Who practiced medicine in New Mexico in 2010?

- There were 1807 UNM trained MDs licensed and practicing in New Mexico in 2010 (page 5)
- Approximately 40% of all physicians licensed in New Mexico trained at UNM (1807/4549, pages 5 and 6)
- Approximately one of every four physicians trained at UNM is practicing in New Mexico (1807 of 6707, page 2)
- MDs who trained at UNM for both phases of their medical education (medical school and medical residency) are twice as likely to practice in New Mexico as MDs who trained at UNM for only one phase of their medical education (MD Only 372/1556, Medical Residency Only 951/4236, MD and Medical Residency 484/915, page 2)
- UNM trained MDs are practicing in 29 of New Mexico's 33 counties (page 4)

2010 Specialty Information

- Roughly half of all UNM trained MDs licensed in New Mexico practice in the primary care specialties of family medicine, internal medicine, obstetrics & gynecology, or pediatrics (893/1807 total UNM trained MDs in NM, page 7)
- About 20% of UNM trained MDs licensed in New Mexico practice in one of four specialties: anesthesiology, general surgery, emergency medicine, or psychiatry (402/1807, page 8)

About UNM School of Medicine

- UNM School of Medicine graduated its first class of MDs in 1968 and its first class of resident MDs in 1955 (see notes on terminology below)
- On average, 75 MDs graduate from UNM School of Medicine each year
- Approximately 125 MDs begin residency training in New Mexico each year; roughly 500 medical residents and fellows were in training at the UNM School of Medicine in 2010

A Note on Terminology:

All MDs who graduated from UNM School of Medicine or who completed all or part of their residency at UNM are referred to as UNM trained MDs.


UNM Trained MDs fall into three mutually exclusive categories:

- MD degree from UNM, Medical Residency out-of-state (**MD Only**)
- Medical Residency at UNM, MD degree out-of-state (**Medical Residency Only**)
- Both MD degree and Medical Residency at UNM (MD and Medical Residency)





Figure 2: UNM Trained MDs in New Mexico, 2000, 2005, 2010

Figure 3: UNM Trained MDs in Primary Care Specialties in New Mexico, 2000, 2005, 2010






Figure 4: UNM Trained MDs with New Mexico License and Address by County, 2010

Location Report 2011: The Approach and Methods

Our intent in this report is to provide the best available information about UNM School of Medicine (SOM) graduates and medical residents who were in New Mexico in the past year. It is important to note that any recent moves or change in location by these individuals may not be reflected in our data.

A number of sources were used in the compilation of this report. The lists of University of New Mexico School of Medicine MD recipients (since 1968) and former residents (since 1955) were obtained from two sources: the UNM SOM's Office of Student Services and Office of Graduate Medical Education (GME), respectively.

Several additional sources were used to confirm both names and New Mexico address/location. These included the New Mexico Medical Board 2011 Official List and a dataset of UNM SOM graduates maintained by the Office of Program Evaluation, Education and Research at UNM School of Medicine.

The basis for including individuals in the 2011 Location Report was twofold:

- 1) the individual was included in the 2010 Location Report, or
- the individual was included on the New Mexico Medical Board 2011 Official List in one of the following categories:
 - information about physicians returning to New Mexico
 - information about physicians who completed residency training in the past year, were licensed to practice and were practicing in New Mexico
 - information about Osteopathic Physicians contained in the Active Roster section of the Official List

We developed several strategies to obtain information about the current location of individuals included in the Location Report. Data collection for this report began in the summer when the first of three survey mailings was sent to SOM graduates to confirm their practice location. The next phase of data collection began in the fall when we contacted medical staffing offices at hospitals throughout the state to verify physicians with hospital privileges. We obtained information from the UNM SOM GME office about residents and fellows who recently completed training. Finally, we researched and contacted individual doctors, clinics and offices to confirm physician location.

Notes related to specific tables:

Tables 2-4: Public Health Regions

When presenting data by region, we used the five public health regions in the state of New Mexico as defined by the New Mexico Department of Health.

Table 2B: New Mexico Population

When presenting New Mexico population data, we calculated MDs per 10,000 population using 2010 New Mexico county population estimates from the US Census Bureau (table: Population & Housing Occupancy Status: 2010).
